JULY 2007 PRICING SCHEDULE RELEASED

Wellard Rural Exports has released its July 2007 pricing schedule for dairy cattle, sheep and beef cattle.

The MV Becrux is loading out of Darwin and Broome in early to mid-July, and prices for feeder steers and steers have been set at \$1.70 a kilogram and \$1.55/kg respectively for that shipment.

Wellard's sheep prices for July 07 are for delivery to Wellard's Baldivis feedlot.

Heavy wethers are achieving prices of \$60+, while prices for wether lambs are in the \$45-\$50 range.

Wellard has improved its spot prices for young dairy heifers, 320-380kg, and is now offering \$750-\$850 a head on the east coast, and \$700-\$850 a head on the west coast.

Forward contact prices for dairy heifers, delivered October 2007 – May 2008, have remained stable.

Wellard Rural Exports managing director Steve Meerwald said despite an appreciating Australian dollar, Wellard had posted attractive prices for July to attract stock in a period of tight supply for almost all categories.
