New Zealand and Mexico now benefiting from Wellard expertise

The Governor of the State of Mexico has officially welcomed a shipment of sheep and dairy heifers from New Zealand, transported by Wellard NZ Limited, a wholly-owned subsidiary of the Wellard Group.

The shipment of 3601 pregnant Friesian heifers and 34,500 pregnant ewes were shipped to Mexico aboard the MV Deneb Prima, with a voyage success rate of more than 99.9 per cent.

The livestock will be used in private and Government breeding programs in Mexico.

Mexican State Governor Enrique Peña Nieto welcomed part of the shipment at a ceremony held at the Grupoagroindustrial farm on Saturday June 2nd, 2007.
